“Un-accounted For Water” Project Details

Un-accounted For Water(UFW) represents the difference between the total volume of water fed into a system, and the total legitimate consumption.

UFW usually rises either because of leakages due to poor quality infrastructure, or pilferage & unauthorized use.

Consumption - ML	474.44	498.83
Other Component - ML	4.50	9.008
UFW - ML	391.61	232.994
UFW%	46.29%	29%

- Total number of house service pipes replaced - 24372 out of 30530 houses.
- Leakage addressed - 3132.

Some of the benefits of reducing UFW are:

- Reduced UFW directly translates to less wastage or loss of a precious resource.
- Reduced UFW means more water is available for channeling to those who need it.
- In addition to the value of water itself, treatment & supply involves costs. Reduced UFW means that these costs are not wasted.
- More revenue and accurate data for utilities.

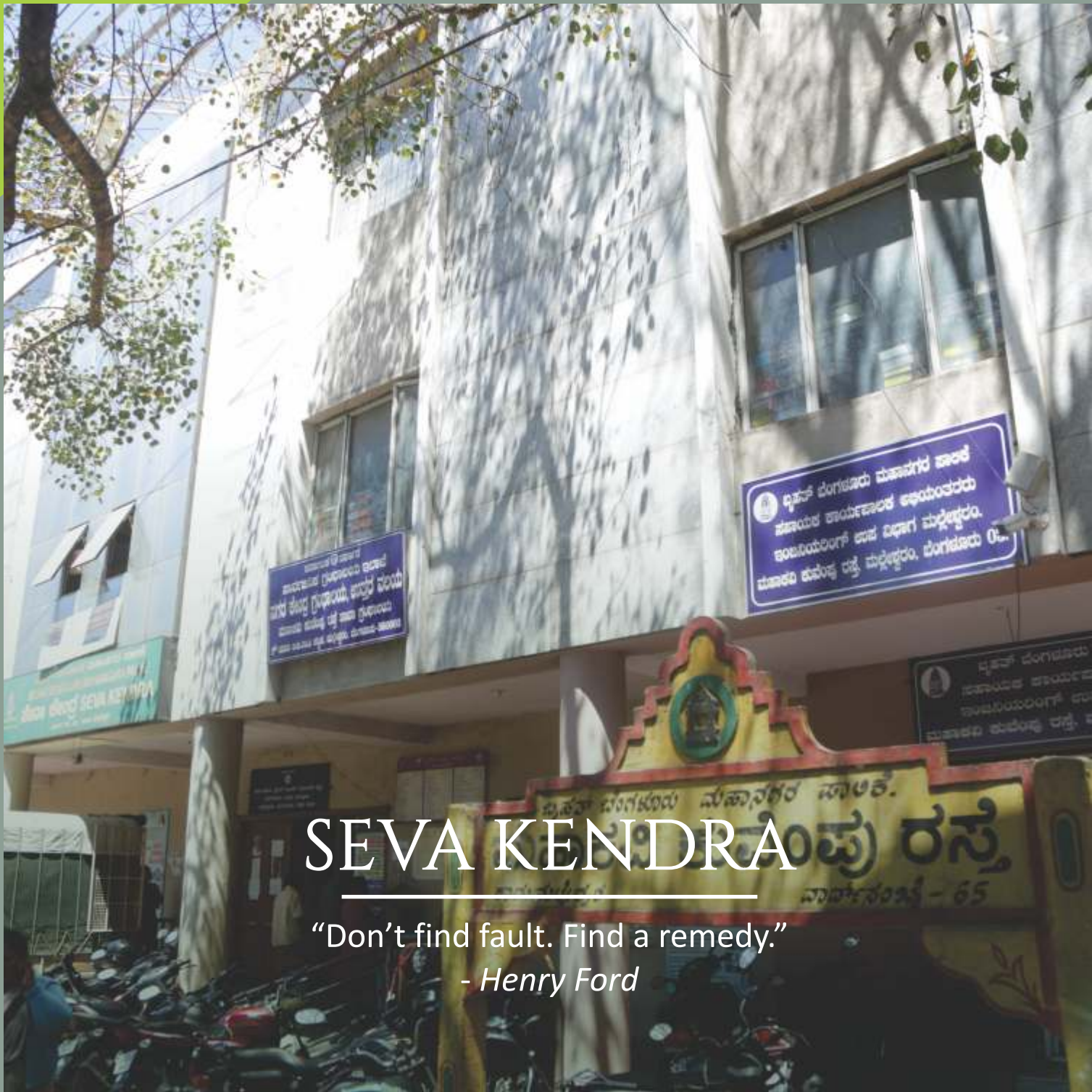

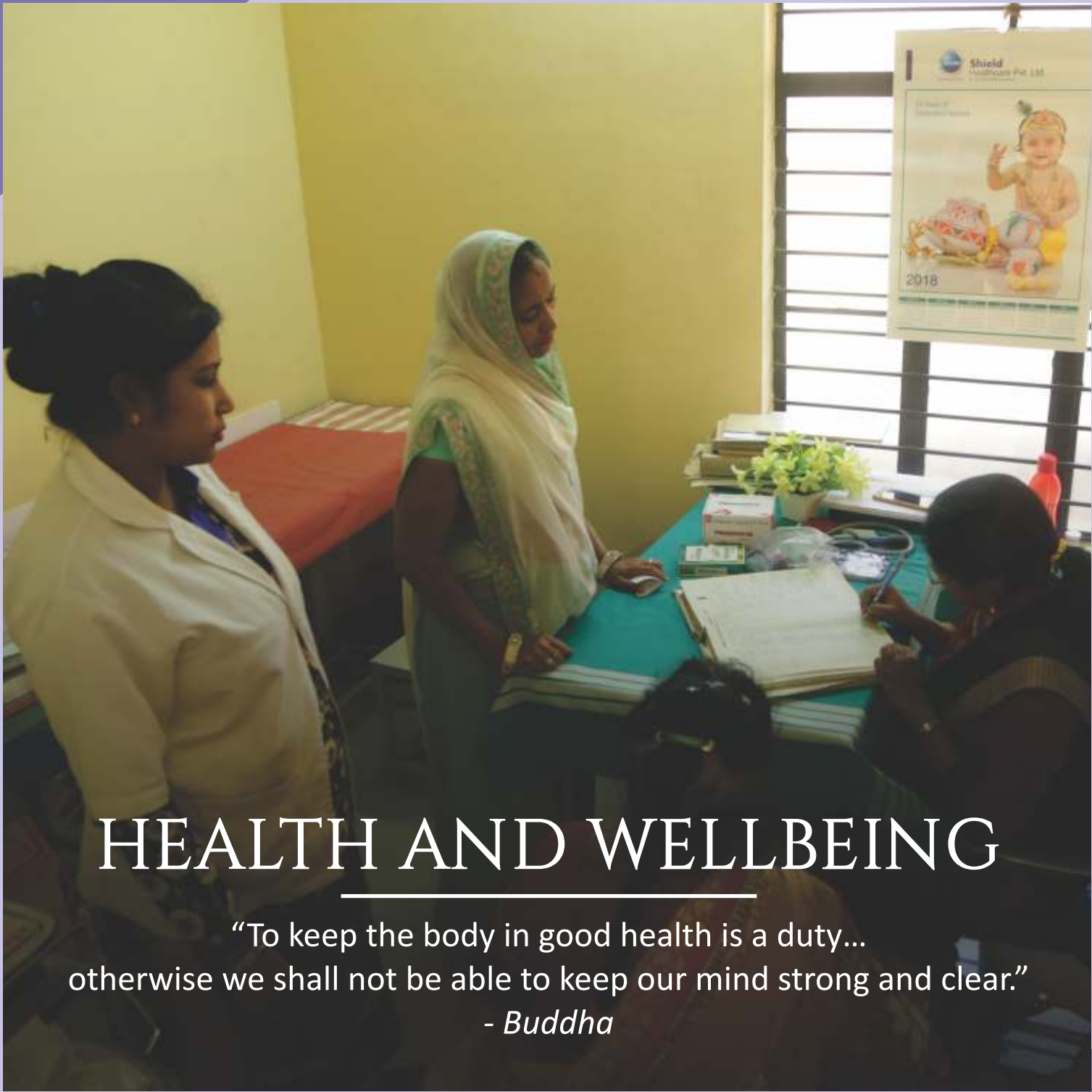

- Today, Malleshwaram is one of the most sought after areas and has been declared “black-spot free” due to the dedicated efforts of the citizens under the leadership of Dr. Ashwathnarayan C. N.

- To provide an end to end solution for solid waste management, Malleshwaram has adopted a multi-pronged approach by setting up Dry Waste Collection Centres in all its wards, an Organic Waste Compost to handle Wet Waste and a Bio-Gas plant that provides electricity to over fifty street lights.

- The door to door pick up of garbage is integrated with block-wise smart collection & transport to a single lorry point to ensure that no garbage is dumped on the ground.

- Thanks to the waste segregation efforts, the amount of waste being sent to the landfills has drastically reduced!

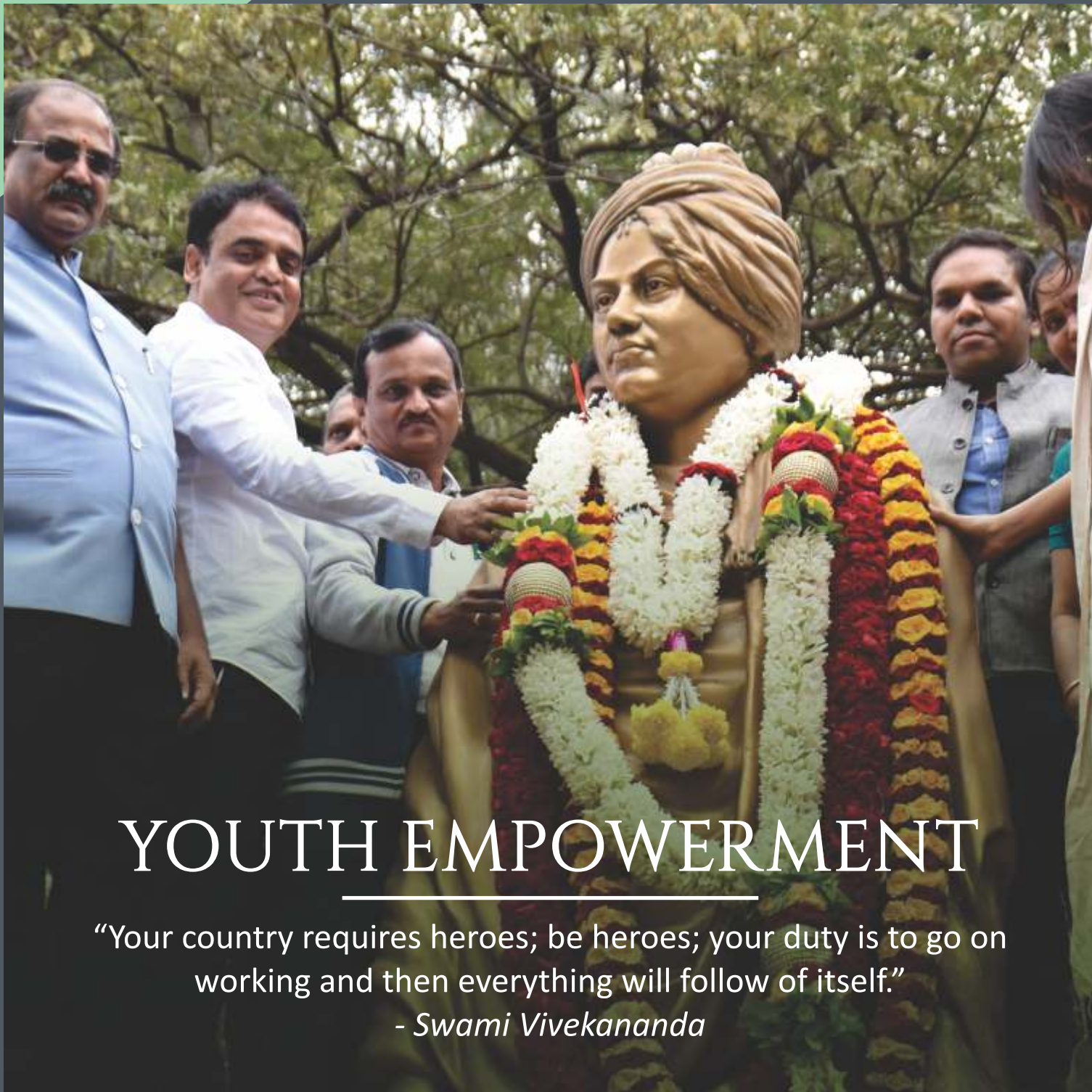

Youth Empowerment



Dr. Ashwathnarayan C. N. believes that there is a need to revamp the skill development ecosystem to meet the requirements of the industry. By providing appropriate skill training to its youth, Bengaluru can become a human resource capital which will reap favorable dividends. His initiatives in youth empowerment include:

- Organization of mega job fairs in collaboration with Teamlease and IIJT, where employability of over 5,000 prospective candidates were assessed and evaluated by counselors.
- The counselors helped youth to identify the necessary vocational skills & training they needed to meet the industry's requirements. Major companies like WIPRO, Future Group, Shoppers Stop, Unisys, Karvy Consultants, ICICI First Source, Sparsh, and Synova have been participating in these job fairs for the last three years.
- Several skill development training programs in tailoring, basic computer skills, carpentry etc., aimed at plugging the growing skill gaps have been organized across Malleshwaram.
- In 2016, an event focussed on 'Rebuilding Tomorrow' where industrial experts addressed the youth on critical global issues.
- The theme for 2017 centred on "The Future of Jobs in India" where professionals like Ravi Gururaj from NASSCOM and Ian Faria of Talk Temple outlined the job challenges of the future.
